

An outdoor learning programme is embedded in our curriculum and from the very youngest children to those in Year 6, the opportunity to get out and commune with nature, learn about the earth, the trees, the birds, is an important part of their education. Den-building, rope swinging, stick whittling and clay modelling all contribute to the sheer joy of freedom and having the time to think. ASSESSMENT

WE ARE A PROGRESSIVE SCHOOL, AND BELIEVE THAT CHILD CENTRED, NON-PRESSURED LEARNING HELPS OUR CHILDREN FULFIL THEIR POTENTIAL. THIS APPROACH DOES NOT MEAN THAT WE SACRIFICE OUR STANDARDS. WE HAVE EXTREMELY HIGH EXPECTATIONS FOR OUR CHILDREN WHEN THEY ARE PREPARING FOR THEIR NEXT SCHOOL, WHETHER THEY ARE SITTING THE 11+ OR MOVING TO A NON-SELECTIVE SCHOOL. IN EITHER CASE THEY DO SO CONFIDENTLY AND WELL PREPARED.

> CHILDREN WELL, WE NEED TO KNOW WHERE THEY ARE WITH THEIR LEARNING SO THAT WE CAN TAILOR OUR APPROACH TO THEIR SPECIFIC NEEDS. BY LISTENING TO OUR CHILDREN AND THROUGH CAREFUL QUESTIONING AND OBSERVATION, OUR TEACHERS UNDERSTAND WHAT OUR CHILDREN KNOW AND WHAT THEY CAN DO SO THAT THEY CAN ADAPT THEIR LESSONS ACCORDINGLY.

REPORTING PROGRESS

TEACHERS MEET WITH PARENTS TWICE A YEAR FOR COLLABORATIVE LEARNING CONVERSATIONS AROUND THEIR CHILD'S PROGRESS AND ATTAINMENT. PARENTS TAKE HOME A CELEBRATORY CHILD-LED LEARNING JOURNEY WHICH IS SHARED WITH YOU, YOUR CHILD AND THEIR TEACHERS. WE ALSO HAVE MORE FORMAL ASSESSMENTS TO KEEP TRACK OF OUR CHILDREN'S PROGRESS, WHICH ARE ADMINISTERED IN A STRESS-FREE ENVIRONMENT.

AT THE END OF THE YEAR YOU WILL RECEIVE A VERY DETAILED FORMATIVE REPORT ABOUT YOUR CHILD'S PROGRESS, COMPILED FROM CAREFUL OBSERVATION BY THE TEACHER, TO ASSESS HOW YOUR CHILD'S LEARNING JOURNEY IS PROGRESSING AND WHAT THEIR NEXT STEPS WILL BE.



LIFE AFTER DALLINGTON

Dallington enjoys continuing close relationships with many of the schools our children choose as their next step.

We spend a lot of time getting to know each individual child, finding out what they like, what they are good at, what sort of school they think would suit them. We then talk to you, the parents, to find out what your hopes and dreams are for your child. We don't put any unnecessary pressure on children by spending hours on exam papers, but we ensure that children feel ready and prepared for their secondary school transition.

A carefully designed model provides the children with transferable life-long skills which incorporate our core values of relationships, empathy, creativity, individuality, play and enjoying the journey.

ADAPTIVE QUESTIONING

Children complete a variety of questions using an AI tool, which adapts the difficulty of the questions depending on how well they are able to answer them. This ensures that the questions are pitched correctly for each child so that they all feel appropriately challenged. Children answer questions in maths, comprehension, verbal reasoning and non-verbal reasoning.

CREATIVE WRITING

A regular extra lesson specifically focussing on developing children's creative writing skills, enables and encourages them to take risks and utilise their powerful imaginations to develop wonderful pieces of writing that will engage an audience.

PUBLIC SPEAKING & PERFORMING

With an extra drama lesson each week, children have the opportunity to build their confidence with public speaking and performing in front of others. How to effectively use their voice with the correct breathing and an awareness of gestures, helps them feel grounded and comfortable in their own skin.

MINDFUL PRACTICES

Learning about different parts of the brain and their function, children develop techniques to help calm the amygdala so that they can think clearly and be the best versions of themselves. ADMISSIONS PROCESS

- Book a personal tour of the school with our Head of Admissions.
- 2. Complete the registration form and pay a nonrefundable registration fee of £150.
- 3. Once your child has been registered, we will place their name on the entry list for that year and places will be offered 3 terms prior to entry. If your registration is made closer to the date of entry, an offer will be sent straight away.
- 4. Once you receive an offer of a place via email, the deadline for acceptance is 7 days after the offer date. Places are secured by completing the online forms which will then direct you to pay your deposit. Your child's place is secured on the successful completion of all stages of this process.

ENTRY POLICY

DALLINGTON HAS A NON-SELECTIVE ENTRY POLICY: WE WORK ON A FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED BASIS AND TAKE CHILDREN FROM 3-11 YEARS OLD. THERE IS NO ENTRY TEST AND MOST CHILDREN JOIN US AT THREE AND FOUR YEARS OF AGE.

SNACKS, LUNCH AND PLAYTIME


BOWLS OF FRESH FRUIT ARE PROVIDED IN EVERY CLASSROOM FOR CHILDREN TO HELP THEMSELVES DURING THE DAY. NURSERY CHILDREN ARE GIVEN A SUBSTANTIAL SNACK IN THE MORNINGS BEFORE GOING OUT TO PLAY. CHILDREN ARE REQUIRED TO BRING THEIR OWN HEALTHY PACKED LUNCH.

LUNCHTIMES ARE SUPERVISED BY A DEDICATED TEAM OF LUNCHTIME ASSISTANTS, AS WELL AS OUR FULL-TIME STAFF. AFTER LUNCH THE CHILDREN WALK ROUND TO THE PLAYGROUND IN SEWARD STREET – A SHORT WALK FROM SCHOOL – AND HAVE ABOUT 45 MINUTES OF OUTDOOR PLAYTIME. SPORTS LESSONS ALSO TAKE PLACE HERE, AS WELL AS AT IRONMONGER ROW BATHS, WHERE CHILDREN HAVE WEEKLY SWIM LESSONS.



LOCATION AND TRANSPORT

DALLINGTON SCHOOL IS HOUSED IN A FORMER VICTORIAN CHURCH SCHOOL WITH LARGE AIRY CLASSROOMS SPREAD OVER FIVE BRIGHT, HIGH-CEILINGED, OPEN PLAN FLOORS. MANY CHILDREN ARRIVE ON FOOT, OR BY SCOOTER OR BICYCLE, BUT WE ARE WELL-SERVED BY UNDERGROUND STATIONS AT BARBICAN, FARRINGDON, OLD STREET, AND ANGEL, AS WELL AS BEING ON BUS ROUTES 4, 55, 56, 153, 243.



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
